1. Buddhism temple "Bilyi Lotos" (White Lotus)

This is the only Buddhism temple in Europe.

2. Blue Palace

The first place that comes to your mind when you think of Cherkasy. It was built in the 19th century upon the project of an architect V. Horodetskyi.

3. Shukhov Water Tower

Hyperboloid tower, constructed in 1914. There are less than 20 of such towers left in the world.

4. Cherkasy zoo

A complex for carnivores "Land of Wolves and Bears" and a terrarium make this zoo unique.

5. Chernecha Hora (Tarasova Hora)

It is a burial place of Taras Shevchenko.

6. A national dendrological park "Sofiyivka" and Fantasy Park

It is one of the seven wonders of Ukraine.

7. Tomb of Rabbi Nachman and Jewish residential section of Uman

"Small Israel" and a place of pilgrimage of bratslav Hasids from all over the world.

8. The fountain complex "Perlyna Kohannia" ("Pearl of Love") with a magnificent light and music laser show

It is one of the three largest light and music fountains in Ukraine.

9. Vasylian Monastery and its mysterious underground tunnels

The oldest building in Uman which offers you a tour of its mysterious underground tunnels.

10. Symyrenko's family estate

This is a place where the family of Symyrenko lived. Here the Renet Symyrenka variety of an apple tree was bred as well.

11. Church of St. Peter and Paul

This architectural site was built in 1796.

12. An equestrian center "Parade Allure"

One of the biggest equestrian centers in Ukraine. It specializes in horse breeding and training.

13. Ski resort "Vodianyky"

This is a modern resort with all the necessary infrastructure.

14. The Motherland of Taras Shevchenko

This is a place where Taras Shevchenko was born and where he spent his childhood.

15. Krasnohirska Women's Monastery

This is one of five oldest monasteries in Ukraine (built at the beginning of the 17th century).

16. Tiasmyn Canyon

This is a natural wonder which is 2 billion years old.

17. Pushkin and Chaikovskiy museum

Olexandr Pushkin and Petro Chaikovskiy created their masterpieces here.

18. A mammoth hunters' camp

This camp is one of four primitive man sites discovered in Europe. Here you can see primitive people's dwellings built of large bones and mammoth tusks.

19. Church of St. Dmitry

This is a unique wooden architectural site of Right-Bank Ukraine built in 1773.

20. The Manor of dukes Lopukhin-Demydov

This is a park and garden complex built in Romanticism style of the 18th - 19th centuries.

21. Korsun-Shevchenkivskiy Canyon (Shumky)

22. Taras Shevchenko's Well

This is a well where Taras Shevchenko took water.

23. Buky Canyon

This is a real natural wonder which is called the lost world.

24. A resort complex "AKVADAR"

This is an eco-friendly resort located in the middle of the forest.

25. Dakhovskiy's Castle

4 generations of Polish landowners of Dakhovskiy have been creating this wonderful architectural complex (from 1770 to 1917).

26. Windmill

This is the only windmill in the region which is still operational. It was constructed in 1908.

27. Caves of Irdynskiy Vynohradskiy (Vineyard) Holy Assumption Monastery

This monastery was first mentioned in 1656. Haidamaky hid here from their pursuers. Yurii Khmelnytskyi (a son of Bohdan Khmelnytskyi) took the monastic vows in this monastery after his repudiation of authority.

28. The hunting palace of Count Shuvalov

This is an architectural site of the beginning of the 20th century, built in French Renaissance style.

29. Trypillian settlement

This giant settlement with the total area of 450 ha dates back to the 3rd-4th millennium BC. A natural reserve "Trypillian culture" was created here.

30. St. Nicholas Valley

This is one of three places in the world, where on a granitic stone are the footprints of St. Nicholas and Holy Mother.

31. Dendrological manor park

This is a park which form resembles a tulip.

32. Residence of Bohdan Khmelnytskyi

This historical and architectural complex is built on a place where in the middle of the 17th century was the Hetman's capital.

33. Motronynskiy Women's Monastery

This monastery was founded in "Kholodnyi Yar" in the place of Scythian Motronynskiy settlement.

This oak is over 1100 years old.

It is a family vault of the Hetman Bohdan Khmelnytskyi.

This is the only wooden building created by architect V. Horodetskyi in 1894.

40. Historical and ethnographic open-air museum "Cossack lands of Ukraine"

This museum is an open-air model of Cossack settlement of the 17th-18th centuries.
